CLASSROOMS

When you step inside our spacious and ergonomically designed classrooms, you'll see welcoming displays of student perspective, creativity and teamwork. We also move our classwork outside for extra learning, fun and a breath of fresh air with story time in the garden, science experiments in the corridor, Social Studies conversation in the open space where a teacher's vision is to make learning happen everywhere.

Our teachers are well-versed in using technology to support learning. Our classrooms are equipped with interactive boards, internet connectivity and accessible laptops making teaching and learning a true 21st century experience.





LABORATORIES

A lab, first and foremost, is a place for experiments and hands on learning, be it science or other specialised areas. The experience derived from hands-on, acts as a driving force behind the decision to take learning to a higher level. Students thrive in the unique environment of the laboratories and the workspace exhibiting the real joy of learning.

Knowing this well, SRMPS has designed exclusive labs for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Computer Science, Language Engineering Graphics and Robotics and STEAM. Our well-planned laboratories create a working environment that not only benefits students but our teachers too.



MAKER SPACE @SRMPS

Makerspace provide hands-on, creative ways to encourage students to design, experiment, build and invent as they deeply engage in science, engineering and tinkering.

A maker-space in our school is not solely a science lab, carpentry unit, computer lab or an art room, but it contains elements found in all of these familiar spaces. Therefore, it is designed to accommodate a wide range of activities, tools and materials.

Diversity and cross-pollination of activities are critical to the design, creation and exploration process, that has set our Makerspace/ STEAM lab unique.



LIBRARY

SRMPS has a hand crafted Junior and senior library program with certified school librarians with library program designed for students & staff fostering critical thinking and nurturing analytical reasoning and communicative skills. Our library is a learning hub opening the windows to the world through digital learning tools and resources giving opportunity for students & staff to explore the world of literature, knowledge and wisdom.

Our library houses more than 7000 valuable books ranging from fictions to subject enrichment books with well-crafted library program to instill confidence in reading in multiple formats, which is fundamental to learning and personal growth.

READ TO LEARN

Silent reading fluency, often an 'unseen and unheard' skill, is tested on a daily basis. Beginning in grade 3, students move into the 'read to learn' phase of reading, where they must continually strengthen a range of skills as they move through the grades and are expected to independently read and comprehend increasingly complex text.



INFIRMARY

Our fully functional junior and senior first aid centres are staffed with qualified nurses during school hours with provision for doctor – on – call. We have the support of SRM Multispecialty Hospital, located just 15 minutes away, for emergencies.

SECURITY

SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY

A team of dedicated Male & Female Guards, full – campus CCTV surveillance, fire extinguishers and a key card authorisation for our staff and students are a part of our prioritized security measures.

TRANSPORTATION

GPS tracking-enabled buses that indicate their arrival and departure through SMS are available for the students. Our buses are also equipped with CCTV surveillance and Speed Governors.



HIDE-OUT CAFE

Our cafeteria has a menu of healthy and nourishing meals recommended by a certified dietician. The highest standards of hygiene is maintained by our well-trained staff. We have clean RO filtered drinking water taps at convenient spots within the cafeteria and in all the floors.



OUR CLASSES

We have classes from Lower Kindergarten till Grade 12.

KINDERGARTEN



No feat is too little to celebrate when it comes to our little ones at SRMPS. Our students are cherished, celebrated and nurtured to find their own identity and develop a strong moral conscience from the day they become a part of the SRMPS family.

Our little ones navigate through their early schooling years participating in structured and unstructured activities through SPICE (**S**ocial, **P**hysical, **I**ntellectual, **C**reative, **E**motional) education that aids in their holistic growth.



LOWER PRIMARY

The mother teacher concept at the pre-primary classes help the children to get used to the regular academic stream, moving from the kindergarten wherein the mother teacher takes care of their social, physical, intellectual and emotional needs by giving them enough space to express and settle.



SECONDARY

- ↪ The secondary children (Grades 6 – 10) of SRMPS are encouraged towards deeper learning which emphasis on strengthening the fundamentals of core concepts.
- ↪ The divergent smart classrooms from Grade 6 onwards provide the dynamic versatility in learning that our growing minds need to excel.
- ↪ Tamil, Hindi and Sanskrit are offered to students from Grade 6 onwards as the options to choose for second and third languages respectively.

UPPER PRIMARY

- ➔ Conceptualised learning is practiced from the primary level where the students are introduced to new subjects and concepts including STEAM by strengthening and building on their prior knowledge.
- ➔ Student clubs are available for children from Grade 4 onwards where they can have fun and hone their curricular and co – curricular skills.
- ➔ Tamil / Hindi are offered as second and third languages.

MASS MEDIA

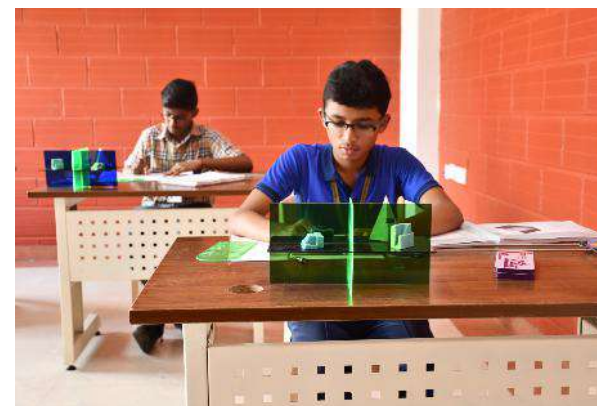

SCHOOL BAND

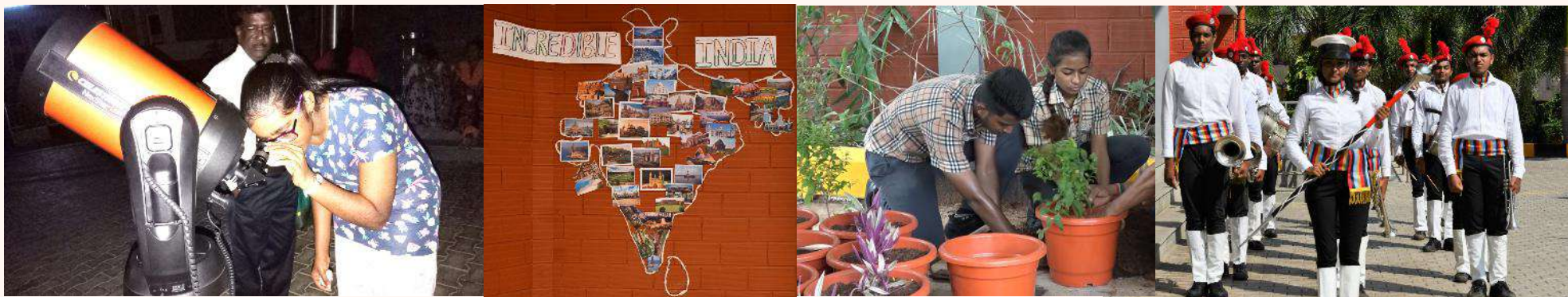
The lovers of music and rhythm unite in the school band of SRMPS. The School Band harmonizes the festivals, celebrations and ceremonies with its harmonious music.
