## THE REMARKABLE PAYLOAD LAUNCH





We are thrilled to share the groundbreaking achievement of our students, who launched their payload at 9:17 am on 16th August from the prestigious ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization) launch site in Sriharikota. This incredible feat was made possible under the expert guidance of Space Kidz India.Our students' payload, SR-0, was onboard ISRO's latest SSLV-D3 mission, Demo SAT. This mission aims to reach a 475 km circular orbit. The SR-O satellite is equipped with two pioneering payloads: the first is a LoRa (Long Range) M2M (Machine-to-Machine) Messaging System, which our students have meticulously developed to enable robust long-distance communication. The second payload is a Pin Diode-Based Dosimeter, a device designed to measure space radiation, contributed by AVS Academy. This launch is a historic milestone for SRM Public School, as we proudly become the first Indian school to launch a payload in Space Rickshaw mode.

This innovative approach allows our students to engage directly with space technology, learning through hands-on experience. The school will serve as the base station for this mission, where students will be able to conduct real-time observations. This achievement not only marks a triumph in the field of education but also represents a significant step forward in making space science more accessible and understandable to young minds. By breaking down the complexities of rocket science, we are empowering our students to reach new heights, encouraging them to explore, innovate, and push the boundaries of what is possible. With this successful launch, Team SRMPS is demonstrating that even the sky is not the limit. We are incredibly proud of our students and excited to see what future innovations they will bring to the world of space exploration.


