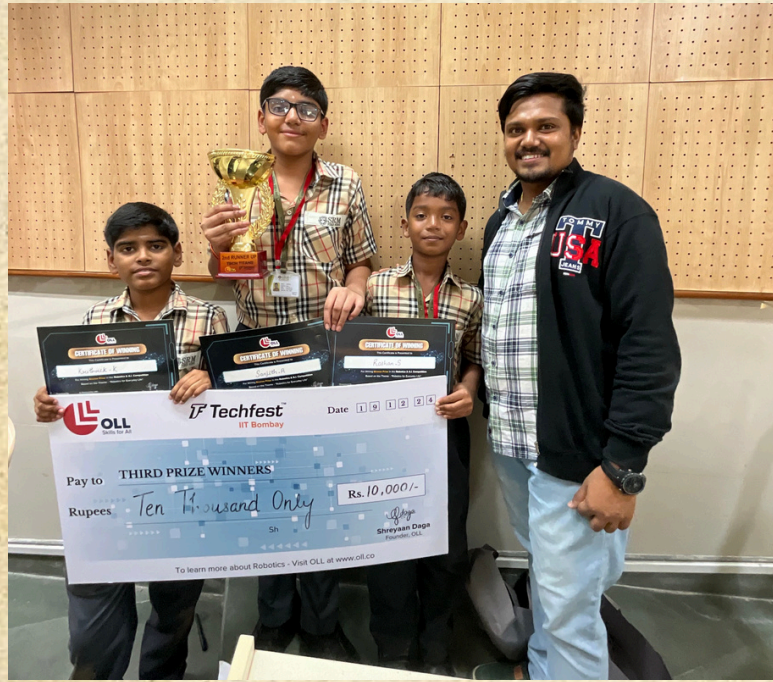
# MATH DAY
